

Bequest Information Sheet

Thank you for taking the first step in creating a lasting legacy for the Bitterroot Valley with a bequest to the Bitterroot Water Partnership. Below you will find some examples of language you might use in your Estate Plans or Will. The following language, **once approved by your lawyer**, can be used in your will or living trust.

Sample Bequest:

"I wish to give (___% of the residuary estate or ____% of the estate or a sum of \$____) to the Bitterroot Water Partnership, located at 162 S 2nd St Hamilton, MT 59840, EIN 43-2000515, to be used wherever it is most needed."

Five common types of bequests:

General Bequests:

This is a gift of a *specific dollar amount*. For example, you might choose to leave \$20,000 to the Bitterroot Water Partnership.

Residual Bequests:

This is the most common type of bequest, because it ensures that loved ones receive their distribution first. This gives the *remainder of your assets to Bitterroot Water Partnership after all other distributions have been carried out*. It could be the entire remainder of your assets, or a certain percentage of the remainder.

Specific Bequest:

This is the gift of a specific asset. For example, you might donate land, a car, or art.

Percentage Bequest:

A percentage bequest specifies a particular *percentage* of your estate. For example, you might choose to give 10% of your total estate to Bitterroot Water Partnership.

Contingent Bequest:

This is a gift that is only given if specific conditions are met, such as the passing of a beneficiary. You could specify that should a primary beneficiary (such as a spouse or dependent) pass before you, the assets should go to Bitterroot Water Partnership.
