

Note from the Director

In 2023, our organization achieved significant milestones by welcoming great new staff, moving into a bright, new office, and celebrating 30 years of conservation successes. Through change and growth, we remain committed to protecting water quality and wildlife habitat, preserving water quantity, and promoting watershed stewardship.

Because of you, last year alone we engaged nearly 300 students in stewardship activities, completed two restoration projects to enhance westslope cutthroat trout habitat, and connected with hundreds of community members through guided hikes, volunteer days, the River Clean-Up, and Water-Wise garden installations.

The major financial investments last year were deliberate and reflect our long-term vision, resulting in a temporary

budget deficit as we spend a portion of our reserves to expand our capacity to get more done for our waters.

We're excited to continue our work and grateful for your support as we connect, learn, and conserve the Bitterroot.

2023 at a Glance

Conservation Engagement

This year has emphasized our communities' desires to be engaged in active stewardship of our waters!

We hosted **TWO** Water-Wise Landscaping Workshops with **FIFTY** residents, installed **TWO** demonstration gardens, and sold nearly **FORTY** Water-Wise Plant Packs in the program's **FIRST** year! Combined with over **TWENTY** pounds of native, seed, these packs helped convert **TWO** acres to Water-Wise Landscapes. Are you ready for year two?

- 1000+ River Clean Up bags used, keeping countless pounds of trash out of our River
- 100 new students enrolled in our Earth Stewardship Program, now reaching nearly 300 future stewards
- 5 Trails & Tributaries nature and stewardship hikes with 25 people

Stream Restoration

- 1,900 willows planted
- 600 feet of streambank restored
- 200 pounds of sediment pollution reduced annually
- 1 native fish passageway restored
- 2 miles of streamside roads repaired
- 82 hours of restoration site maintenance
- 310 pounds of invasive, non-native weeds removed

In the midst of caring for **FOUR** of our recently completed restoration projects, we implemented **TWO** new projects!


